

Important Instructions for Candidates

Candidates are advised to read carefully and comply with these instructions, as also the instructions given by the Invigilator/Venue Superintendent/Supervisor at the test venue.

Before the Exam

- **Timing of Exam:** 1 PM to 3 PM. (2 Hours)
- **Venue of Examination:** Academic Block, Central University of Punjab, V.P.O Ghudda, Punjab.
- Reach the exam centre **Two hours** before the scheduled time. Candidate entry in the test centre will be stopped **30 minutes** before the start of exam and no candidate will be allowed to enter after **12.30 PM**.
- **Candidates must bring the following documents for examination:**
 - Filled admit card (Application Form filled on PSDM website) with Roll number written over it by hand (please check the roll number on the website) and recent passport size colour photo pasted over it.
 - Government issued ID card (original; Aadhar Card/Voter ID Card/Driving license/Passport)
 - Self-attested photocopy of **10th class certificate**
 - Self-attested photocopy of **Qualifying Exam Certificate (B.Sc Nursing/GNM)**
 - Self-attested photocopy of **Nursing Council registration certificate**
 - Self-attested photocopy of **2 Years' Experience certificate (Only in case of GNM)**
- **No other document than the above is required to be carried.**
- **Do not carry any original certificates other than Identity card.**
- Carry your own only Blue/Black ball pen and three ply masks.
- Please comply to the covid-19 precautions like social distancing and wearing three ply mask.
- Mobile Phones will not be allowed in the examination centre.

At Time of Entry

- Show your Admit Card and the official govt. authorized ID.
- Obey all guidelines in order to ensure a smooth transition.
- Candidates will be scanned through thermo guns and will be asked to sanitize their hands before entering.

During Exam

- The candidate will be provided with the question paper and OMR sheet.
- The candidates will not be permitted to leave the examination hall till the end of examination.
- **DO NOT** attempt to cheat or make any suspicious movements which can cause disqualification.
- The invigilator will mark the attendance of the candidate and collect the required documents from the candidate during the examination.

After Exam

- Once finished, candidates will have to leave the exam centre in an orderly fashion.
- Candidates will have to submit the Question paper along with the answer booklet to the invigilator.

COVID-19 Safety Instructions

- **DO NOT** remove your mask at any point of time.
